
To remove fog or frost on the windshield:

- Set the airflow control to the defrost (\(\mathbb{P} \)) position. (The A/C will turn on automatically and "Fresh" mode will be activated.)
- Set the temperature control to the desired setting.
- Set the fan speed control to position "3" or "4".

NOTE: If the air conditioner filter for the evaporator blower is not replaced as per the Scheduled Maintenance section, excessive window fogging may result. This filter is located in the evaporator housing behind the glove box. Your dealer can replace this filter for you.



NOTE: You can lengthen the life of your wiper blades by gently wiping the rubber inserts with an alcohol soaked rag to remove grime and road debris.



Lumbar Support Control, Driver's seat only To adjust the lumbar support, move the lever on the outboard or left side of the seat do the desired position.



Manual Seat Controls (if installed):


- To raise or lower the front part of the seat cushion, turn the front knob (A) forward or rearward.
- To raise or lower the rear part of the seat cushion, turn the rear knob (B) forward or rearward.
- To recline the seat back, pull up on the seat reclining lever (C).



Power Seat Controls (if installed):


Seat Back Reclining Control Switch (A).

Pull and hold lever while adjusting steering wheel tilt, and then release the lever.

NOTE: Do not attempt to adjust the steering wheel while driving.



Press the lock switch to deactivate the passenger power window switches.



Keyless Remote and Locks

- A. Press UNLOCK on the transmitter to disarm and unlock the driver's door. Press UNLOCK again within 4 seconds to unlock all the doors.
- B. Press LOCK on the transmitter to lock all the doors and arm the alarm. Press LOCK again within 4 seconds to receive confirmation from the turn signals.
- C. Push and hold the TRUNK RELEASE button on transmitter for longer than 1 second to open the trunk.



- Move the selecting switch to the right or left to activate the corresponding door mirror.
- · Now, adjust the mirror angle by depressing the appropriate perimeter switch as illustrated.
- Place the selecting switch in the middle posi tion to deactivate the perimeter switch.


Note: The outside rearview mirror heaters work in conjunction with the rear window defroster and will turn off automatically after several minutes or when the engine is stopped.


To select automatic mode, shift to D.

To select SHIFTRONIC™ mode move the shift lever right to the manual shift gate. The instrument cluster displays the selected forward gear.



Tire Inflation

Check tire pressure at least once a month when the tires are cold. Refer to the tire pressure label located on the driver's door lower edge for correct pressure.



The trunk / fuel door releases are located on the driver's door as shown.



Fuel Cap



After adding fuel, always reinstall the fuel cap fully and make sure it clicks at least 3 times. Failure to do this may result in the "Check Engine Light" illuminating.

Basic Safety Precaution

- Whenever operating the vehicle, make sure that you and your occupants are properly wearing your seat belts.
- Small children should always ride in the rear seat in the appropriate child restraint system (see Owner's Manual for child safety details).
- Never place children under thirteen years old in the front seats to avoid injury that may result from air bag deployment.
